Dear Parishioners,

On behalf of the Temporal Affairs Council (TAC), I am pleased to present the parish's financial report for the year ended December 31, 2022 and our budget for 2023. While I have decided to highlight only a few important items below, I encourage you to review the attached financial statements for more details.

Overall, ordinary revenues for 2022 were approximately \$158,000 compared to \$174,000 in 2021. This decline in revenue was due to an end of the federal government pandemic assistance as well as a decline in collections.

However, I believe the parish remains in good financial standing as we have a sufficient cash balance to cover operating costs. More importantly, I am encouraged by the increased parish activity and optimistic that our 2023 balanced budget is attainable.

Needless to say, your continued support will be critical to increasing our collection revenue for 2023 to \$182,800 in order to achieve a balanced budget this year.
