### Fr Bob writes:

In our second reading this Sunday, to the Christian community in the city of Corinth, St Paul speaks of the anxieties connected with various states of life and the necessity of adhering wholly to the Lord. Christians are called to be free of distracting anxieties, especially, for Paul, in view of the impending return of the Lord. Human concerns tend to obscure spiritual vision in every state of life. Even those who are single in God's interest tend to become preoccupied with features of their spiritual life.

Daily concerns and marital responsibilities place a strain on those who are married. Elsewhere Paul speaks of his preference for the celibate life. Neither state of life is given preference here. The single state may well offer less stressfilled concerns, but it is quite possible that in Corinth, it had spawned a form of elitist asceticism. Paul shows no indication of being dogmatic in his counsel nor does he indicate a plan of action for his audience.

Time is running out. What is paramount is a Christ-centred life. Paul gives the same advice to the married and unmarried and, interestingly enough, to women and men equally. He wants the Corinthians to be able to prepare in the best manner possible for Christ's return; thus he wants them to have less care. This state is achieved more readily in one who can devote himself entirely or almost entirely to the things which pertain directly to God.

### Next Weekend: Men's Cursillo Weekend

The Ottawa Cursillo Movement is holding a Men's Weekend from February 1-4 at Centre de L'Amour in Plantagenet. The weekend is called a Cursillo. Cursillo is a Spanish word meaning "little" or "short" course. The Cursillo begins on Thursday evening with a short introduction and orientation and then the retreat phase begins. The weekend also includes a daily celebration of the Mass and times of prayer. A good part of each day is



spent listening to talks given by a priest and Catholic lay men followed by group discussion. There are three meals provided each day. The weekend ends late Sunday afternoon. No one is too well informed or too spiritual to make a Cursillo. Cursillo could be for you. The Cursillo Movement is a powerful instrument of renewal in the Catholic Church. Its aim is to concentrate closely on the Person and teachings of Jesus Christ. The Cursillo gives those who attend it a living understanding of basic Christian truths and the desire to serve the Church. 



### Catechism Corner

Is there a priority of one sex over the other? No. God endowed men and women with identical dignity as persons. Both men and women are human beings created in God's image and children of God redeemed by Jesus Christ. It is just as unchristian as it is inhumane to discriminate unjustly against someone because he is male or female. Equal dignity and equal rights, nevertheless, do not mean uniformity. The sort of egalitarianism that ignores the specific character of a man or a woman contradicts God's plan of creation.

What is love? Love is the free self-giving of the heart. To have a heart full of love means to be so pleased with something that one emerges from oneself and devotes oneself to it. A musician can devote himself to a masterpiece. A kindergarten teacher can be there wholeheartedly for her charges. In every friendship there is love. The most beautiful form of love on earth, however, is the love between man and woman, in which two people give themselves to each other forever. All human love is an image of divine love, in which all love is at home. Love is the inmost being of the Triune God. In God there is continual exchange and perpetual self-giving. Through the overflowing of divine love, we participate in the eternal love of God. The more a person loves, the more he resembles God. Love should influence the whole life of a person, but it is realized with particular depth and symbolism when man and woman love one another in marriage and become "one flesh" (Gen 2:24). For example, the annual operating expenditure budget of St. Philip Parish is approximately \$155,000, which goes towards paying for the following items:

- Paying for the parish priest, the parish office administrator, replacement priests to say Mass and the parish bookkeeper;
- Diocesan tax on parish revenues (donations);
- Utilities (heat, hydro, water, sewer, utilities, etc.)
- Repairs and maintenance on St. Philip Church, the Parish Hall, and other buildings and grounds;
- Office expenses; and,
- Pastoral expenses.


