Fr Bob Writes:

Our second reading for this Sunday comes from the first letter of St Peter. Peter was martyred in Rome between 64 and 67 A.D. The first letter attributed to him in the New Testament likely written from Rome in the time leading up to Peter's death, is addressed to Christians in regions he had evangelized and who were being affected to some extent by the same persecution under Nero, who became emperor in 54 A.D. at the age of 17 and ruled until his death at the age of 31 in 68 A.D. Peter encourages Christians to be strong in the testimony of lives of love for one another and to maintain a positive hopeful attitude based on the promises of our faith.

People should be drawn to ask Christians what motivates them to live in such a way. Then the verbal testimony can be shared with



"gentleness and reverence." During times of persecution, Christians will be able to give testimony by suffering unjust treatment without returning evil for evil. The truth will eventually come out and people of good heart will be drawn to faith in Jesus Christ through such testimony.

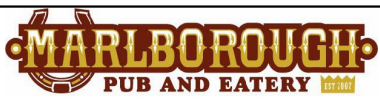


## CHARITY GARAGE SALE & BBQ

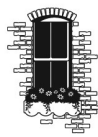

## Catechism Corner

**Was Mary only an instrument of God?** Mary was more than a merely passive instrument of God. The Incarnation of God took place through her active consent as well. When the angel told her that she would bear "the Son of God", Mary replied, "Let it be to me according to your word" (Lk 1:38). The redemption of mankind by Jesus Christ thus begins with a request by God and the free consent of a human being and a pregnancy before Mary was married to Joseph. By such an unusual path Mary became for us the "Gate of Salvation". Dig Deeper: CCC section (493-511) and other references [here](#).

**Why is Mary our mother also?** Mary is our mother because Christ the Lord gave her to us as a mother. "Woman, behold, your son! ... Behold, your mother!" (Jn 19:26b-27a). The second command, which Jesus spoke from the Cross to John, has always been understood by the Church as an act of entrusting the whole Church to Mary. Thus Mary is our mother, too. We may call upon her and ask her to intercede with God. (YOUCAT questions 84-85). Dig Deeper: CCC section (493-511) and other references [here](#).

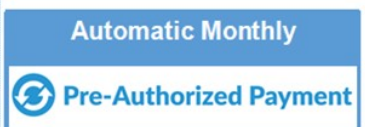

### Why is it important to support the parishes financially?

Just like any other charity or non-profit organization, it costs money to keep St. Philip Parish and St. Clare Mission afloat. For example, the annual operating expenditure budget of St. Philip Parish is approximately \$155,000, which goes towards paying for the following items:

- Paying for the parish priest, the parish office administrator, replacement priests to say Mass and the parish bookkeeper;
- Diocesan tax on parish revenues (donations);
- Utilities (heat, hydro, water, sewer, utilities, etc.)
- Repairs and maintenance on St. Philip Church, the Parish Hall, and other buildings and grounds;
- Office expenses; and,
- Pastoral expenses.

In addition, St. Philip Parish also spends about \$10,000-\$20,000 per year on major projects and renovations to replace and/or renovate the parish buildings and other items within the parish.

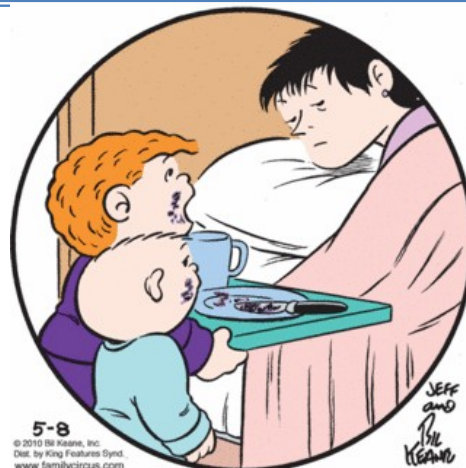
